

English

In English, we will be exploring all things mysterious and writing our own mystery stories. We will look at how to build suspense for the reader and take people on an emotional rollercoaster with unexpected plot twists and turns. Our key text will be the London Eye Mystery, keeping things linked to our UK topic with London being the capital of England (a country within the UK).

In addition to writing our very own mystery stories, we are going to become newspaper journalists, reporting on all of the crazy events that unfold in our key text. We hope you can 'read all about it' when our newspaper is published.

Guided Reading/Read Aloud

This half term, we will be reading 'The London Eye Mystery'. This story is about a young boy Ted, who has asperges syndrome, and his sister Kat work together to solve the mystery of their cousin going missing during a ride on one of London's most iconic landmarks.

PE

In PE, we are so incredibly lucky to have Carlisle Utd. Coming to teach us team games. In addition to this, Miss Scotson will be teaching gymnastics where we will learn how to jump, roll and balance without risking injury.

Maths

In Maths, we are continuing putting our times table knowledge into practice by multiplying and dividing. This half term, we are becoming more adventurous with this and will be learning how to multiply and divide a 3 digit number by a 1 digit number. Before the end of the half term we will be switching to a little bit measure and learning how to work out the area of shapes!

Computing

For our computing sessions this half term we will be taking a deep dive into the world wide web. We will know who created the internet and how we can use it responsibly to accommodate our needs.

RE/SMSC/British Values/PSHE

In RE, we will be learning about the main Islamic beliefs and the 5 pillars of Islam. In RSE we are lucky to have Carlisle Utd. Working with us to teach us how to work together and be resilient.

Geography

This half term in Geography, our topic is 'The UK'.

We will be looking at all the different countries that make up this sovereign country and what their capital cities are. The UK is fortunate enough to have lots of regions with local produce, so we will be diving into the impact of this on the local and national economy by conducting a comparison between two different seaside towns.

Art/Design

This half term we are excited to be working on a block all about colour. We will be experimenting with different colour mixing and looking at how different colour palettes can have an impact on the mood of a piece of art.

Science

In Science, we are looking at 'Rocks'. The children will get their hands on lots of different samples of rocks and looking at their differences and similarities. The children will be able to classify the rocks and will look at how all of the types of rocks are formed.

French
