Where we live

The UK and France

The UK is north of France. Our countries are separated by the English Channel (or La Manche as the French call it).

Giving directions

If you go to a French speaking country (of which there are 24 over a number of continents including Europe, North America and Africa), you may need to ask for directions. This can be easy if you know the names of common shops and important building. It can be harder to give or receive directions especially if you are speaking to someone whose first language is French!

Can you tell the difference between left and right?

The trick with your left hand can help you remember which way is left or right.
