Over the course of this unit, you will learn what each of the translations are for each of these hobbies. Then you will begin to incorporate these into increasingly long conversations.

1	L.O. I can use an English French dictionary  Can you note some hobbies and their French translations?	You will use an English French dictionary to match some French hobbies to their translations.	
2	L.O. I can understand a French speaker when they say simple phrases  Did you find it easy to translate the phrases after listening to a native French speaker?	You will listen to some clips of a native French speaker naming some hobbies and translate what they mean into English. This will test your memory and your listening skills.	
3	L.O. I can ask a simple question and be able to answer the same question using a range of sentence starters  Answer this question in the learning review box: Tu aimes la natation?	You will learn how to ask if someone likes a particular hobby. You may need to use a French English dictionary to understand the question. You will be able to answer the question using a range of sentence openers.	
4 (may take two lessons)	L.O. I can use the correct verb tense  Can you choose the grammatically sentence in the review box?	You will learn that many of the verbs or action words that you use to describe your hobbies in French end in -er. We will learn when and how to change the verb ending. We may also be able to explain hobbies that we do not like or do not take part in.	Tick the correct answer:  Elle jouer au basket.  Elle joue au basket.  Elle joue du basket.
5	L.O. I can translate sentences from French into English  Did you find that each of the translations using the online dictionary made sense in English.	You will read some sentences written in French. You will be able to translate them using an online dictionary. You may be asked to translate some English sentences into French using some phrases you have used in these lessons, in previous units of work and with the help of a French English dictionary.
