## Important information



Islam is the second most popular religion in the world with over a thousand million followers. It is more often thought of as a complete way of life rather than a religion.

Islam began in Arabia and was revealed to humanity by the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). Those who follow Islam are called Muslims. Muslims believe that there is only one God, called Allah.

Place of Origin -Saudi Arabia

Founder-Muslims believe in a chain of prophets starting with Adam.

Sacred Text- The Qur'an

Sacred Building-Mosque

Holy Places-Mecca, Medina, Jerusalem

Major Festivals-Ramadan, Eid-ul-Fitr, Eid-ul-Adha

### **Muslims have 6 main beliefs**

**Belief in Allah** as the one and only God.

**Belief in angels.**

**Belief in the holy books.**

**Belief in the Prophets** (special messengers).e.g. Adam, Ibrahim (Abraham), Musa (Moses), Dawud (David), Isa (Jesus). Muhammad (peace be upon him) is the final prophet.

**Belief in the Day of Judgement...**

The day when the life of every human being will be assessed to decide whether they go to heaven or hell.

**Belief in Predestination...**

That Allah has already decided what will happen.

Muslims believe that this doesn't stop human beings making free choices
