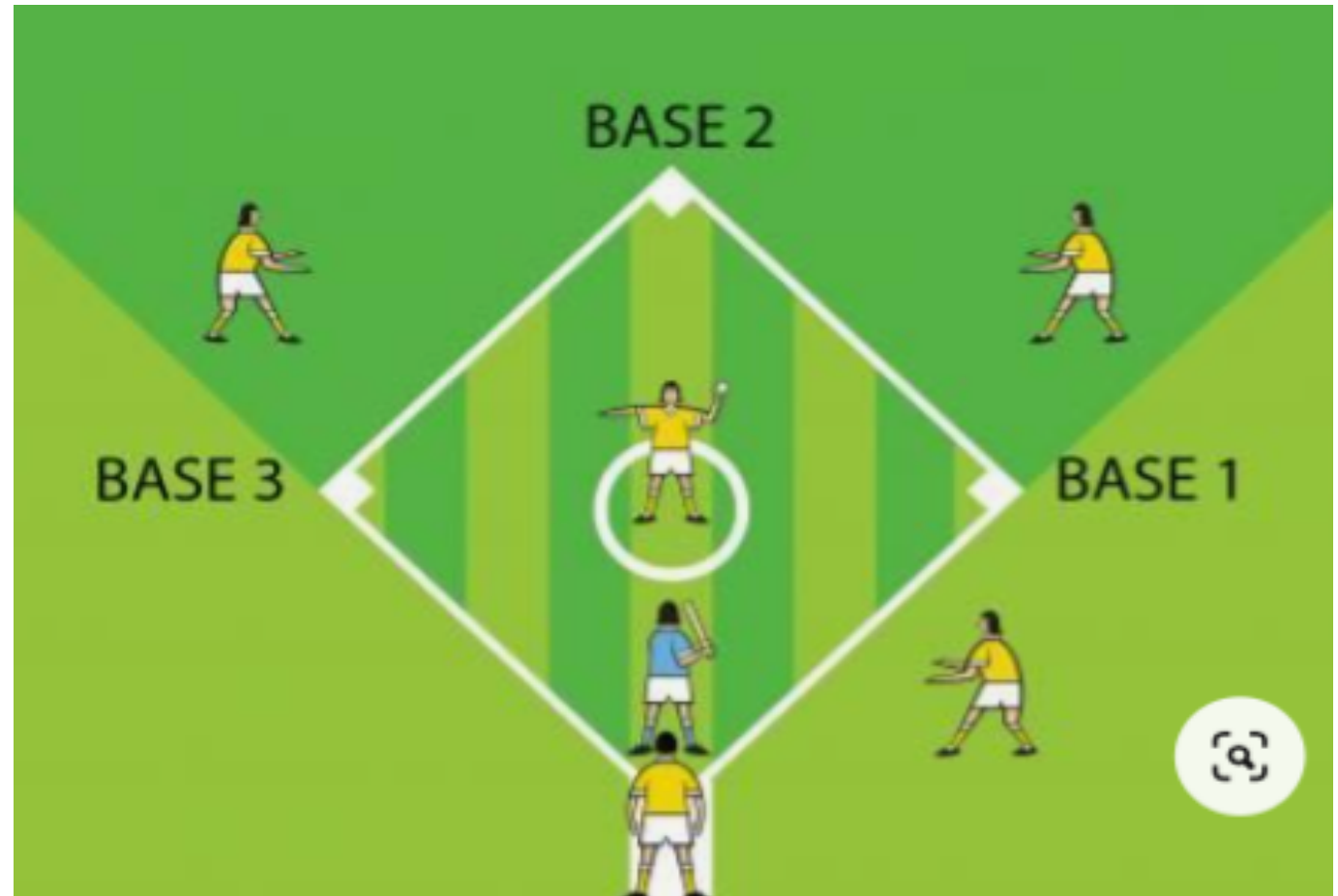


By the end of this unit you understand the rules of the game rounders and apply this when playing the sport. You will also use previously learned teamwork skills to come up with a team strategy.

Rounders is a sport played in two teams- a batting team and a fielding team. The aim of the game is to score as many rounders as possible without being struck out. To score a rounder a person on the batting team has to run all the way round the 4 bases before the ball gets back to the bowler. To prevent this, the fielding team has to quickly pass the ball either back to the bowler or to the base that the current batter is running towards. If the base is stumped before the batter arrives at the base, they're out.
