These words are used to say 'some'.

Use 'du' before a masculine noun like 'chocolat',
e.g. Je voudrais **du** chocolat. *I would like some chocolate*

Use 'de la' before a feminine noun like 'soupe',
e.g. Je voudrais **de la** soupe. *I would like some soup.*

Use 'des' before a plural noun like 'saucisses',
e.g. Je voudrais **des** saucisses. *I would like some sausage.*
