Andy Warhol's birth name was Andrew Warhola

Born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in 1928

He worked in a number of media his most famous works were created using silkscreen and lithography Andy Warhol had an interesting sense of style; he wore silver wigs and eventually dyed his hair silver. After having been told he had lazy eyes, he wore opaque glasses that had a tiny pinhole for him to see through.
